Re: Emergency Procedures for School

The Wausa School District 76R has developed a Crisis Response Plan that is designed to attend to the health and welfare of your child in the event of a crisis.

In most emergencies your child will remain and be cared for at the school they attend. Students will not be allowed to leave the building and a “lock down” mode will be enforced. In the rare event of an emergency affecting the school premises (broken water main, fire, toxic spill, gas leak), all students and staff will go to Thabor Lutheran Church.

We ask that you follow this procedure if you hear of any school emergency:

1. Be prepared for the school-wide alert to be enacted.
2. Turn on your radio or television. We will keep the media informed of vital information.
3. Please do NOT telephone the school or call your child’s cellular phone. We have limited phone lines, and these must be kept open to respond to the emergency. Your child’s cell phone is kept in his/her locker and will not be of use.
4. Please do NOT come to the school unless requested to pick up your child. Any emergency involving your child’s school may mean emergency vehicles and workers must be able to get to the building. If the emergency necessitates relocation of staff and students, the All-Call system will inform you.
5. When the emergency has ceased, the school day will resume, or the day will close as usual
